NMCA Presidents Report – 2022/23 Matthew O’Brien

As we always state, our aim as a Board is to leave the competition in a better position at the end of the season than it was at the beginning. Overall, we have achieved that aim.

Participation

Junior Boys:

Number of teams from under 10s through to under 16s remained the same at 32 teams. Pleasingly we have seen an increase in participation numbers at the Woolworths blasters level and some clubs entering u10 and u12 teams for the first time in recent years.

Senior Women:

Team numbers have remained consistent however we continue to see a high level of interest from existing and new clubs looking to establish a female cricket program and enter teams into our competition. We expect that this area of our competition will continue to see sustained growth into the future.

Senior Men:

Experienced a small drop in team numbers from 76 in the 2021/22 season to 71 teams this year off the back of good increase in interest last season coming back from Covid. We continue to see some interest from clubs in neighbouring competitions enquiring about joining the NMCA and we hope to have favourable conversations soon with the view to adding clubs that align to our values in the near future.

Strategy and planning

We received a grant to fund a strategic planning workshop with Club Map this season. The Board undertook these workshops in January this year and has formulated strategic and operational plans to help propel the competition forward.

Player behaviour

Most of the season progressed with little to no serious behavioural issues. Unfortunately, this positive trend of behaviour in our competition was halted by one of the most serious on field incidents in our history at the Jack Quick Grand Final. Our message in the last few years has been strong and consistent that behaviour of that type would not be tolerated and would be dealt with harshly. The Board has acted in accordance with this, and some tough but necessary decisions were made to protect the NMCA’s reputation in the community and the safety of its members.

Umpiring

Umpiring numbers decreased slightly this season as several regular senior umpires were unable to commit on an ongoing basis. Umpire numbers are decreasing across the country and the NMCA Board is conscious of the fact that we need to be innovative in this area to attract and retain the next generation of cricket umpires to support and expand the existing umpiring group.

The Juniors were also restricted to the One Day game format, however, the season was extended to give more games. The Women's competition also had interruptions but still managed the salvage a Spring season.

Again, our Club's rallied and cricket was off and running.

Jika Shield had pitted Preston Baseballers up against Holy Trinity with Holy Trinity winning their first Jika Shield premiership.

Jack Quick Shield had the Camrea up against Lalor Warriors, with Camrea winning. Unfortunately this game was marred by an unsavoury altercation between the two Clubs and spectators.

Jack Kelly Shield saw Strathewen take on Holy Trinity, with Strathewen earning a return to Quick Shield.

The Women's Competition Spring competition saw Epping defeating Laurimar in the Lorraine Ireland Shield, Hurstbridge defeated Cameron in the Lenore Smith Shield and South Morang defeating Heidelberg in the Heather Baillie Shield.

The Summer Competition had Laurimar defeating Hurstbridge in the Lorraine Ireland Shield, Cameron defeated Northern Socials in Lenore Smith Shield and Heidelberg beating Greensborough in the Heather Baillie Shield.

In the Veterans, Mill Park defeated Preston Baseballers in a high scoring game.

Our Juniors were solid and in the lower sections it is pleasing that we are getting growth in numbers. Dennis proved hard to beat and took out the Under 16 title, The Under 14's had Keon Park winning and the Under 12's having Dennis taking the Division 1 title and Holy Trinity grabbed the Division 2.

In closing, I would like to thank the Club's for their support this season, the Board for trying new formats and the Umpires who, whilst undermanned, did a pretty good job all year.

NMCA - Finance Manager Report (Seniors)- 2022-23 – Ian Giddons

This year we recorded a profit of \$1,958.60, however, this was mainly due to the two (2) massive Fines of \$5,000.00 each to the clubs that failed miserably in their behaviour in the Quick Shield.

However, as these amounts are as-yet not paid & in fact are being disputed to the VMCU and possibly the Courts they may be reduced. Also: as these clubs have been advised that we will not accept their involvement for the 2023-2024 season these amounts are part of the increase in doubtful debts of \$3,520.50.

Overall, not including these amounts the amounts owed by Clubs is down, mostly additional presentation tickets. Some payments have been received that will come into effect next year.

Overall, excluding those 2 large fines \$10,000.00, fines were actually down, by \$910.00, although some clubs are very fortunate that they were not fines for late finishes, this is a blight that has crept in for some but not all clubs.

Whilst we spent \$4,947.80 on Club Map this was covered by a grant.

Also, to assist clubs, we capped the amount payable by clubs for the General Managers Honoria & contributed \$2,450.00 of this expense to save the clubs.

We also contributed \$1,273.00 plus, towards the cost of the presentation.

However, this is partly offset by the raffle proceeds of \$1,194.85.

Considering we banned the 2 above mentioned clubs & refunded their mandatory tickets of \$630.00, this was a good result.

The Hall of Fame new costs was \$1,083.03.

We also spent \$2,016.00 on our headquarters Burland House.

Web-site costs up \$ 869.00 & ongoing Frog Box cost of \$500.00 were also additional costs.

Burland House was rental up \$351.00, no more Covid reduction.

As always, the "Seniors" make a "donation" to the "Junior" Competition, this year \$300.00, last year \$1,100.00.

We still have some "Pink" Senior two-piece balls suitable for one day games, in the "lower" 2 piece grades, & whilst the price of the Red two piece balls will no doubt increase next year, the Pink balls will remain the same price.

I would also like to thank our sponsors, Kookaburra Sports, and Bundoora Trophies, Plenty Valley FM, who all help with cutting our/your expenses. Kookaburra Sports also being our largest benefactor, plus they also provide directly to the clubs training balls worth over \$12,000.00 as part of their sponsorship.

NMCA - Finance Manager Report (Juniors)- 2022-23 – Ian Giddons

Whilst our 'Profit & Loss Statement shows a 'Profit of \$42.40"

This has been mainly due to a donation of \$300.00 received from the Senior Association,

For this year there would have actually been a small loss except for the "donation"

Note, as we try to keep our junior costs to clubs down, so we are looking for donations and sponsorship to cover costs, and not go into "the negative" assets.

At Present our only sponsor is Kookaburra Sport.

After, years of Cricket Australia donating the "new Cricket Format" score books they have now ceased to continue this practice, however due to a "donation" we were also able to not charge the clubs for these Junior Format books. This resulted in a \$560.00 saving to the clubs with Under 10 & Under 12 teams.

We also brought in cheaper balls for the under 12 & 14 age group – this was \$156.00 per dozen an/or team, this was a great benefit to clubs.

Our junior representative cricket program is one of our main expenses and has decreased, as this year we did not run an under 16 team.

The Junior Levy of \$1,400.00 is only a very small portion of this costs.

Personally, I am against increasing any further impost on clubs to cover this, we need to get some sponsorship to help with these costs.

These expenses also include the umpires, clothing and honouriums for the coaches/managers, who put in time, effort and can involve considerable travel.

Hopefully next year we will be able to resurrect our "Girls" cricket, which we be another expense – for next year.

The revenue for Women's cricket was up due to more teams, but the costs also increased.

There were also new costs, of \$3,165.95 for the Womens Rep games and \$557.85 for the T/10 "Festival of Cricket.

There was also a proposal by Cricket Victoria a Junior Director of Coaching, at a cost of \$2,500.00 for two years, it appears this did not go ahead.
