NMCA Presidents Report – 2023/24 Matthew O'Brien

As we always state, our aim as a Board is to leave the competition in a better position at the end of the season than it was at the beginning. This season, for the first time in four years it is clear this is not the case. After three challenging seasons before this one, where we successfully navigated the COVID period and delays due to above average levels of rain, we were nimble and pivoted where required.

What followed was increased participation in men's, junior boys and women's during those years.

The 2023/24 season was one of the most challenging in recent memory. Off-field consumed a tremendous amount of time and resources of the board. Multiple required fixture changes during the season also contributed to uncertainty leading up the end of year break. Despite these challenges, some excellent cricket was played across all sections of the competition leading to some great final's battles.

Participation

Junior Boys:

We had a marginal increase in junior boys teams this season from 32 to 36 teams. Unfortunately, we did not have enough teams to form a viable under 16s competition this season and this continues to be a concern and should be a focus moving forward to assist with the transition to senior cricket.

Senior Women:

Team numbers have continued to grow, and this year featured three grades of 8 teams and another successful spring and summer season. With continued interest from new clubs and teams we expect to see continued growth in women's participation.

Senior Men:

Experienced a significant drop in team numbers from 71 in the 2022/23 season to 61 teams this year. This is the second year in a row of declined participation in this section of the competition. Clubs should give strong consideration this year to what formats their members wish to play so that the board can provide opportunities to increase participation numbers.

Finance

The NMCA spent a significant amount of time and money on legal fees over the last 12 months. The association continues to be in a solid financial position with just over \$68,000 in net assets. Whilst this position keeps to NMCA on solid standing, it limits our ability to invest in additional programs and our ability to provide financial assistance to our member clubs by way of subsidies.

Moving forward

Although I have one year to run on my current term, this is the right time for some fresh leadership of the NMCA and I will not be continuing in the role post this AGM. I am pleased to hear that there are several new nominations for the board by some people highly respected in the NMCA community.

General Manager's Report - 2023-2024

The 2023-2024 season was one of the toughest seasons that the NMCA has had to endure.

The aftermath of the 2022-2023 season where the Association was drawn into a set of circumstances by having to defend our rules and regulations through the Court system, both took its toll on Board Members and Clubs alike. This action caused the Association to lose Board Members which effectively put a huge amount of pressure on the remaining Board Members to provide a vibrant and effective competition.

There is a possibility that we may have Clubs move to other Associations as they fear that the NMCA is not a strong and progressive competition as it once was.

We had other problems that surfaced and decisions were made on a case by case basis, yet it was again another set of decisions that had an unsettling effect on the Association.

Moving forward the NMCA Board needs to be strengthened by attracting more people with skills and talents that will restore the NMCA back to a position of strength.

Our Juniors were another area of concern, with some Clubs electing to play their Under 16's in another competition which completely weakened our whole Junior program. That being said we fielded 8 under 14 teams and two Under 12 divisions. The under 10's took on the Sunday morning time slot which gives them an established time slot.

In the Senior divisions we saw Holy Trinity win their consecutive Jika Shield final, Donath collecting a second premiership in four years in Quick Shield. Olympic Colts proved their dominance in Kelly Shield.

Keon Park, Holy Trinity and Old Ivanhoe Grammarians respectively won the "B", "C" and "D" grade finals.

Olympic Colts and Keon Park won the two One Day Competitions.

Our every increasing Women's competition increased to 24 teams across the three Shield divisions.

Hurstbridge proved very tough to beat and won both the Spring and Summer finals in the Lorraine Ireland Shield. Epping and Heidelberg shared the Lenore Smith shields and in the Heather Baillie Shield we had Olympic Fillies take the Spring final and newcomer Riverside collecting the Summer Shield.

In closing, I would like to thank the Club's for their support this season, the Board for trying new formats and the Umpires who, whilst undermanned, did a pretty good job all year.

Senior -Association - Finance Report

First, of all, the “elephant in the room”, legal costs of \$50,585.94, we did not initiate the legal proceeding, we were the reluctant defendants (along with the VMCU).

We make no apology for trying to provide a safe environment for playing cricket.

For this year whilst our “Loss” was \$52,238.82, but when you take, into account the adjustment for Provision of Doubtful debts \$3,408.00, this brings the Senior “Loss” to \$53,993.94

But there is an adjustment of \$5,000.00 when we were forced to rescind last year Fine for the above mentioned, Club, the “loss” is actually, less then, the Legal Fees

Items of major increase in expenditure include Electricity up \$272.30 – but last year they gave us a credit of \$254.09 for them not sending accounts in a timely manner.

Grand Final broadcast up \$1,150.00 – two days instead of one.

Internet cost up \$413.00, previously following the debacle with the Broadband roll out we had no Internet available.

Frog Box costs up \$440.00 – nearly double

Electronic forms up \$167.18

General Managers Honourum we had to put in \$3,680.00 up \$860.00.

I am loathe to increase the Club’s portion as not all clubs can afford this impost. Fine revenue was down \$430.00, but we took into account clubs familiarising themselves with the “new PlayHq” system, no Fines for players scores this year.

We also contributed \$799.89 towards the cost of the presentation.

However, this is partly offset by the raffle proceeds of \$1,379.65.

We still have some “Pink” Senior two-piece balls suitable for one day games, in the “lower” 2 piece grades, & whilst the price of the Red two piece balls will no doubt increase next year, the Pink balls will remain the same price. Clubs should look at using these, will be at least \$2.00 cheaper.

I would also like to thank our sponsors, Kookaburra Sports, and Plenty Valley FM, who all help with cutting our/your expenses. Kookaburra Sports also being our largest benefactor, plus they also provide directly to the clubs training balls worth over \$12,000.00 as part of their sponsorship.

Junior Association - Finance Report

This year I am happy to announce Profit of \$2,308.98, despite the Junior Club levy reducing by \$150.00, and losing a \$500.00 Sponsorship from Bundoora Trophies, who due to family reasons sold the Business, thanking them for their years of support to our Association.

At Present our only sponsors are Kookaburra Sport and a nameless sponsor for the Junior Formats Score Books.

This "profit" has been assisted by more Women's Teams – Increase of \$675.00 for Women's Team Registration from last year, this competition is getting bigger & better each year, thanks to the hard work of our Women's Manager, Lenore Smith, who does a fantastic job.

Also helped our Club Registration by \$175.00.

We also were able to reduce or Representative cost as "Digger" Goodwin of Holy Trinity who ran our Junior Representative program "gratis", he was also able to track down a lot of "Coaching" gear from one of our previous Managers who did not return it, thanking you "digger".

This was also, despite not getting as much back from the VMCU to help, reducing their re-imburement of "Umpires Costs from \$70.00 per Umpire Match Fee to \$40.00, as they were also "sued" which cost them greatly, which was monies they had set aside for their Junior Carnival.

We were also able to attain at a reduced costs coloured polos as the manufacturers have discontinued that item, this reduced the Representative Clothing costs for both the Women's & Junior Rep teams.

We also purchased extra which is why the "Asset" Representative Clothing has doubled in value.

However, sizes may be a problem, so next year and some players may have to have a different top to some of their teammates, but they are getting them for nothing, I bet some will still complain.

After, years of Cricket Australia donating the "new Cricket Format" score books they have now ceased to continue this practice, however due to a "donation" we were also able to not charge the clubs for these Junior Format books. This resulted in a \$540.00 saving to the clubs with Under 10 & Under 12 teams.

We also brought in cheaper balls for the Women's Competition (same Ball as under 12 & 14 age groups) – this reduced their cost from \$40 to \$28.00 (per Red Ball) this was a great benefit to clubs.

Our junior representative cricket program is one of our main expenses the Junior Levy of \$1,250.00 is only a very small portion of this costs.

Personally, I am against increasing any further impost on clubs to cover this, we need to get some sponsorship to help with these costs.

These expenses also include the umpires, clothing and honourums for the coaches/managers, who put in time, effort and can involve considerable travel.

Hopefully next year we will be able to resurrect our "Girls" cricket, which we be another expense – for next year.

The costs of the Hire of Grounds for the Women's T/10 "Festival of Cricket also increased by \$293.11 as more grounds were available and Council Charges do increase for "Casual Bookings".
